WORKSHOP History:

WORKSHOP Overview:

Throughout the world a changing working environment with increasing demand, evolving technologies and a shortage of personnel challenges the health workforce to work differently. Blurring the boundaries between professions (trans-professional practice) by extending or expanding the scope of practice will address some identified areas of need. For trans-professional practice a practitioner acquires some of the skills of another profession, not to compete but to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of their intervention and improve the outcome for their client. In this workshop participants will discuss what this means for dietitian-nutritionists, what is driving the adoption of different ways of working, the implications and barriers to change and what ICDA could do to facilitate change.
