The World Health Organization (WHO) and other organizations promote collaboration among health providers to improve health outcomes. Overall, better decisions are made in the workplace because of the enhanced critical thinking and team problem-solving. 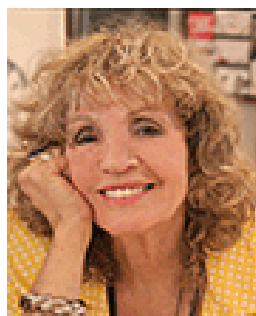
