### **WORKSHOPHistory:**

A preliminary version of this topic was undertaken at the 16<sup>th</sup> ICD in Sydney in 2012. The previous workshop explored the need for the development of competencies for the international Dietitian-Nutritionist community.

### **WORKSHOP Overview:**

Since 2012, the ICD has used an international expert group to develop a set of competencies to describe the ability of entry-level dietitian-nutritionists around the world. We have now identified five units or domains of competence for entry level; dietetic process and professional reasoning; evidence based practice and applications of research; quality assurance of dietetics practice; professional relationship, communication and partnerships; knowledge essential for the practice of dietetics. In this workshop, participants will discuss the competencies, and issues around the adoption of these. Participants will provide advice to the ICDA regarding implementation and how best ICDA can facilitate their uptake.

### **WORKSHOP Proposal: All details**

The background paper that underpins this workshop has been prepared and will be circulated to all member associations prior to the ICD. Participants will also be provided with the document prior to attending and it will be available on the ICDA website.

There is an expectation that attendees will be familiar with competence, competence assessment and implementation. The background paper is a consensus document, fully referenced and developed by experts in the field.
